About Us

After 1947, Independent India witnessed the emergence of reorganisation of higher education in the country, radically different from the colonial perspective and perception. Our national leaders adopted a wider perspective on the character of higher education in free India. The Purpose of higher education was felt by Prof. Bijoy Krishna Bhattacharya a well-known freedom fighter and Satyagrahi. Prof. Bhattacharya's dream became a reality when on August 16, 1948, the college was established with the help of Late Kiron Chandra Sinha, Late Bholanath Mukherjee, Late Krishnadhan Chatterjee, Late Dr. Beni Charan Dutta and Late Ganesh Chandra Mukherjee.

Named after the renowned homoeopath and educationist late Dr. Dinobundhoo Mukhopadhyay the college has a chequered history as it struggled to get it founded and to keep it afloat. Among the many stalwarts who have influenced and encouraged its growth, we also have late Dr. Mahendralal Sirkar after whom the Physics department is named. Dr. Sirkar, a close friend and associate of Dinobundhoo Mukhopadhyay, himself had established the Indian Association near College Street where Sir C.V. Raman worked right before he won the Nobel Prize for Physics. The association is later shifted to Jadavpur and it is now the renowned Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science.

Our college is situated in the Southern Part of Howrah Municipal Corporation Area on the west bank of the river Hooghly, very close to Vidyasagar Setu (i.e., Second Hooghly Bridge) and on a major arterial road in the city, viz., the Grand Trunk Road. It is therefore, well connected to all other parts of Howrah city, the district and the Kolkata metropolis.

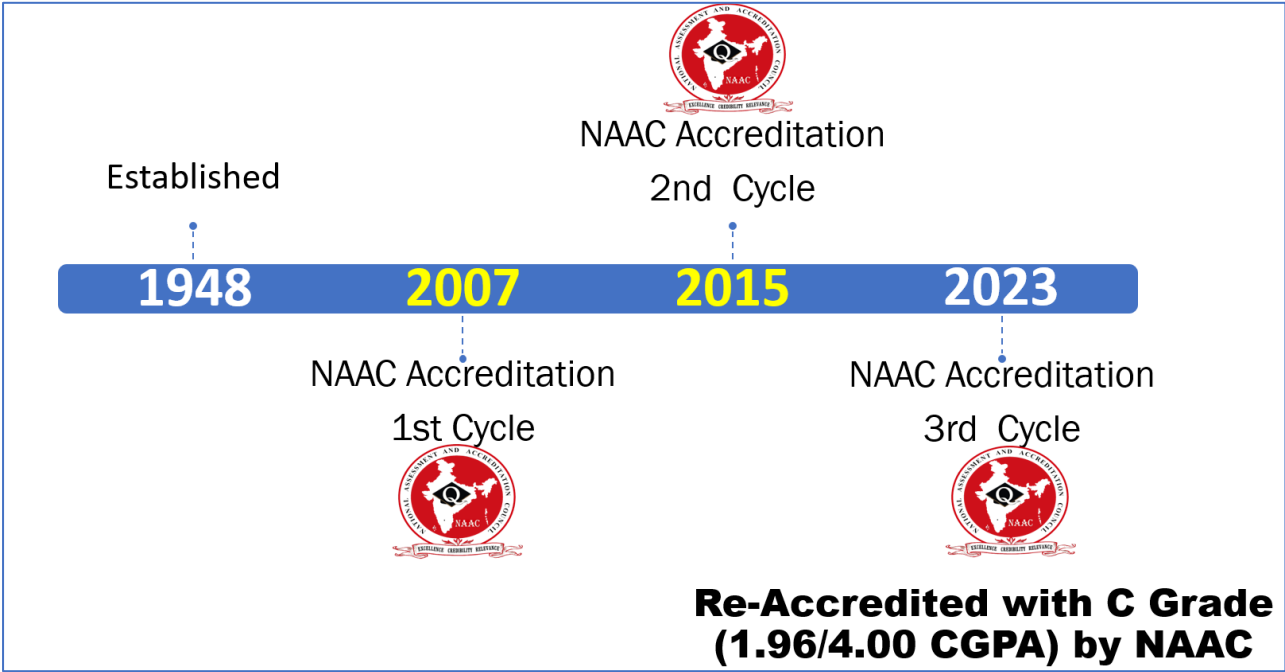
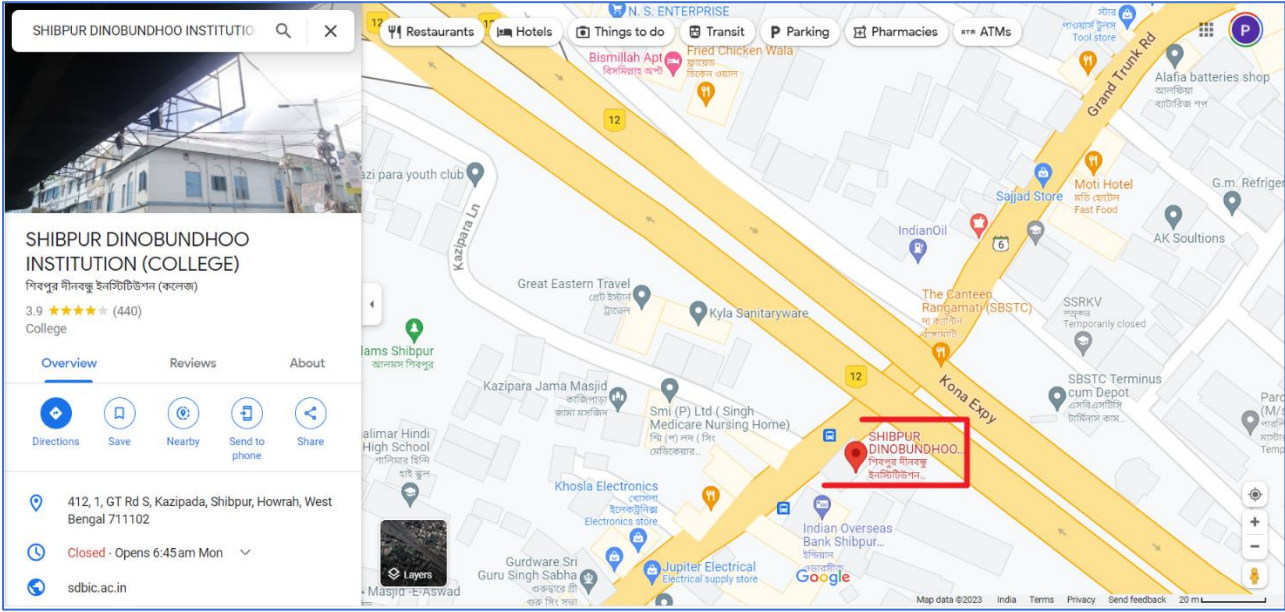
Our college, which is popularly known as DB College is one of the pioneer colleges embracing a vast hinterland of urban and semi-urban areas of Howrah district in West Bengal. Established in 1948, the college has consolidated its position as one of the leading institutions of the district, imparting undergraduate learning in diverse areas of Humanities, Social Sciences, Bio and Pure Sciences and Commerce. 20 undergraduate departments (including 14 Honours subjects) and one post-graduate department are running in a three shifted college (morning, day, evening) as a monolithic college. Morning shift is meant for female students and for pursuing B.A. General Courses. Day shift is co-educational and is meant for B.A. General, B.A. Honours, B.Sc. General, B.Sc. Honours, B.Com. General, B.Com. Honours courses and M.Com. courses. Evening shift is meant for male students and for pursuing B.Com. General, B.Com. Honours courses. From the academic session 2009-10, the college is proud to have introduced Regular Post Graduate Course in Commerce (M.Com.) offered by the University of Calcutta. The college is also running Study Centre of Netaji Subhas Open University since 1998. From 2016-17, Post Graduate Course (Distance Education) in Chemistry (M.Sc.) under Vidyasagar University has been introduced.

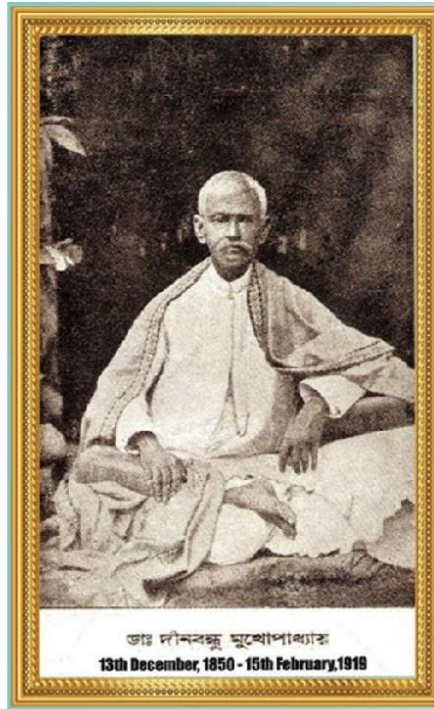
Enrolment in the college gradually increased during the 1950s. Science subjects were introduced in 1958. A tremendous growth in demand for higher education among the local population was observed during 1960s and 1970s. In 1960s, the college was permitted to open Honours course in English, Bengali, History, and Commerce. Subsequently, the college opened Honours courses in Pure Science subjects.

Since then, the college is functioning as a coveted place of higher learning to inspire and guide the young minds of urban and semi-urban areas in the district of Howrah and adjoining areas. The college has come a long way and grown into a NAAC accredited institution of repute. Generations of administrators, teachers, staff members and students have, over the years, made significant contributions towards the development of the college.

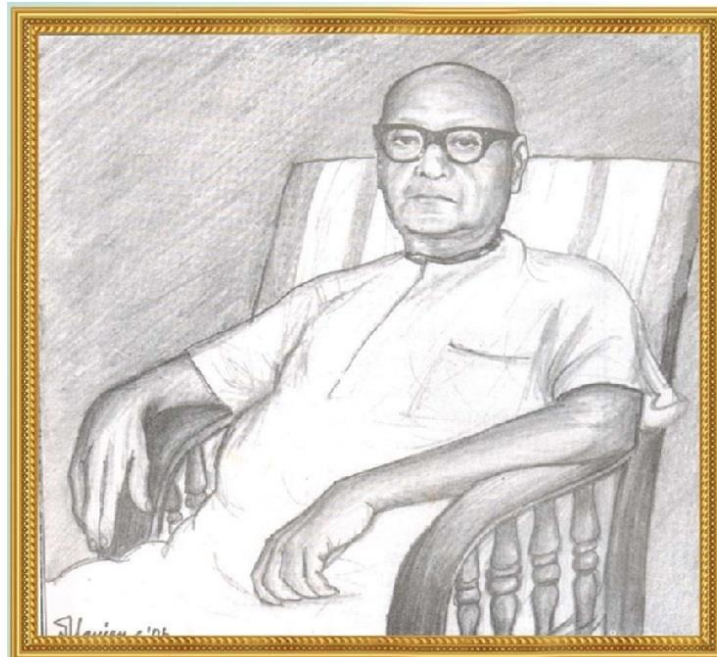
