

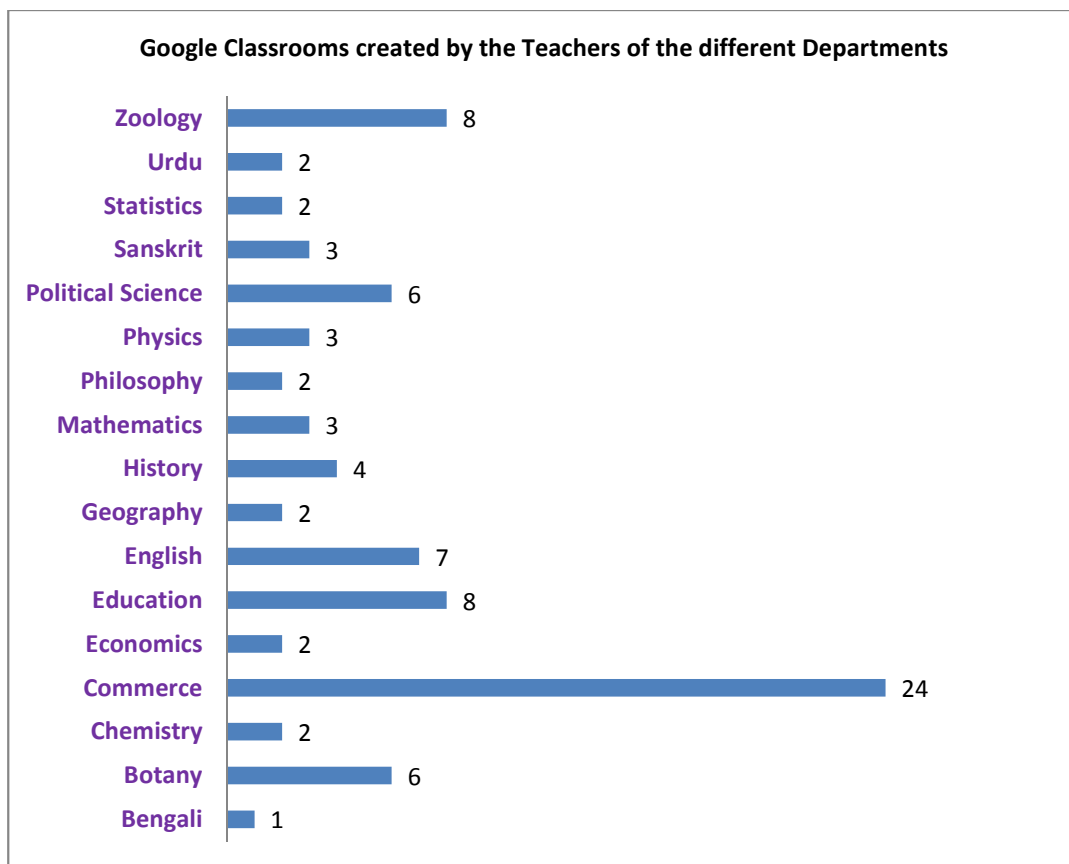

## THE NEW ACADEMIC ORDER

Academic institutions are frantically searching the way outs so that the disruptions caused by the corona virus do not upset the classroom teaching. In our college, introduction of Online Classes through Google Classroom was pioneered by the Department of Botany w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2020 only as an application of cloud-based learning-interface in classroom-teaching. However, after the imposition of the lock-down, online classes have become the way of teaching by default. The changing scenario has made us to relook at our teaching skills. We are also to discover, how relevant we the teachers are in the changing teaching-learning paradigm. 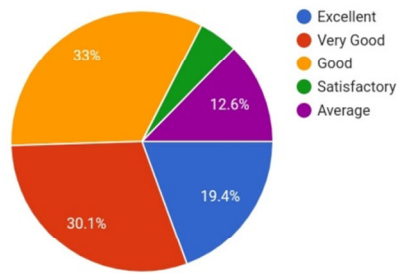

Q 1. Quality of Online Classes are

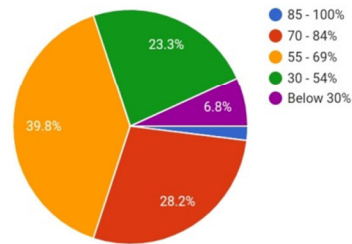

Q 3. Percentage of syllabus covered

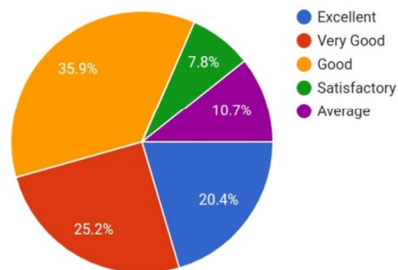
(till date) is

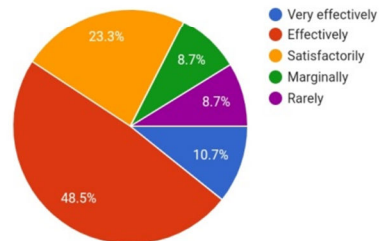
Q 2. Online Class Facilities are

103 responses



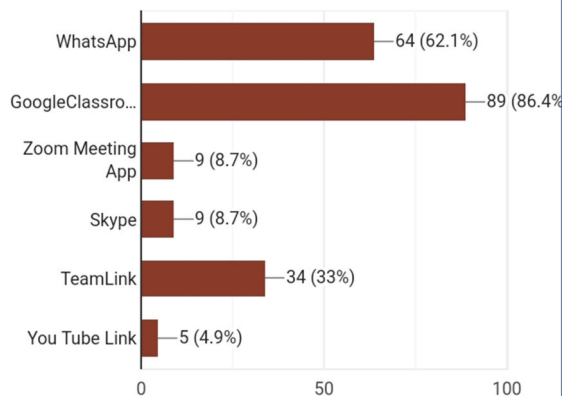
Q. 4. During suspension of classes (due to COVID-19 pandemic), Online Classes are helping you.....
